It is a combination of business, science, and information technology. Health Information Technology professionals care for patients by caring for and protecting their medical data.

With a degree in Health Information Technology, you'll be prepared to work in hospitals, nursing homes, mental health facilities, and other medical institutions. As regulations and technologies evolve, Health Information Technicians can expect to be in high demand as the medical sector continues to grow due to an aging population. The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) projects that there will be a 13% growth rate for HIT professionals, with approximately 27,800 new jobs anticipated by 2026.
